## CHAPTER 2 DIVISIONS OF THE CORPORATION

Article 1. Divisions.

Sec. 2-101. There shall be two Divisions of the Corporation, as provided by Indiana Code § 16-22-8-28. These shall be the Division of Public Health and the Division of Public Hospitals.

Article 2. Division of Public Health.

Sec. 2-201. The Division of Public Health shall serve as the Marion County Public Health Department with the powers and duties conferred by law upon local departments of health and by the Board. The Division shall be under the supervision of a Director, who shall be an officer of the Corporation.

Sec. 2-202. The Division shall have the following subdivisions:

- (a) Public Health Administration.
- (b) Bureau of Environmental Health.
- (c) Bureau of Population Health.

Article 3. Division of Public Hospitals.

Sec. 2-301. The Division of Public Hospitals shall operate the Corporation's hospitals, medical facilities, and mental health facilities. The Division shall be under the supervision of a Director.
