









PUBLIC HEALTH LAB CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

September 2024

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Health & Hospital Corporation of Marion County (HHC) is beginning work on a number of construction projects expected to take place over the next three to five years – mostly on the main health department campus near the intersection of East 38th Street and Keystone Avenue.

First will be a three-acre redevelopment and the construction of a new two-story public health laboratory, clinic and administrative building.

CURRENT ACTIVITY

Perimeter fencing has been placed around the site, which is bounded by East 38th Street on the south, East 39th Street on the north, North Rural Street to the west, and Meadows Drive to the east. Rural Street will remain open for the duration of construction.

A groundbreaking ceremony for the Marion County Public Health Lab was held on September 26.

FUTURE PLANNING

Additional projects will include the renovation of the former Chase Bank Building at 3950 Meadows Drive into HHC's Security headquarters, and the construction of a new Indianapolis Emergency Medical Services headquarters in the 3200 block of East 38th Street.
